# 2023 BASKETBALL WAGGA WAGGA SPRING MEN'S DIVISION 1 - Z LEAGUE COMPETITION INFORMATION PACK



Welcome to the 2023 Wagga Wagga Basketball Spring Men's Division 1 - Z League Competition. This information pack is to provide you with as much information about our competition season as possible. We will provide additional information as it is confirmed.

## **General Information**

- Generally, Men's Division 1 will follow the FIBA Rules
- Initial 1 week will be 1 hour scrimmage session on 21st August 2023
- Competition commences week beginning Monday 28th August 2023
- 9 weeks of regular season games, in addition to 1 week for Grand final
- Grand final game of 1 v 2, no other finals to be held
- Uniform will be supplied by the Association
- Uniforms will be collected directly after your team's last game of the end of season by Team Captains and returned to the sub-committee.

## **PCYC Membership Required**

PCYC Adult Membership This is an upfront 12 month for people OVER 18 years old to join PCYC NSW. \$30.00 per 12 months

PCYC Junior Membership This is an upfront 12 month membership for people UNDER 18 years old to join PCYC NSW. \$15.00 per 12 months

Parking is available under venue \* charges apply

## Uniforms

All players must be correctly attired to take the court. Any player playing out of uniform will result in their team losing 5 points per player out of uniform. Points will be awarded to the captain of the opposing team. A uniform comprises Shorts and Singlet.

Each player in each team must wear the uniform applicable to his team. Men's Division 1 uniforms are to be worn during Z League games only, anyone found wearing a uniform outside Z League competition will result in a 5 point advantage to the opposing team in their next game. Any damages to uniforms inc drawstrings missing or lost uniforms will incur a replacement fee approx \$55 per item for the individual player to pay.

Any damage to uniforms during Men's Div 1 games must be reported to the Senior Competition Director and/or Zac Maloney on the night damage occurs.

# Teams/Draft

- Sub-Committee will select Captains prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> scrimmage
- After 1st scrimmage session the draft will be conducted
- At the draft Captains selection order will be drawn from hat
- At the draft players are selected as follows

Round 1

- o Captain 1 1st pick
- o Captain 2 2nd pick
- o Captain 3 3rd pick
- o Captain 4 4th pick

#### Round 2

- o Captain 4 5th pick
- o Captain 3 6th pick
- o Captain 2 7th pick
- o Captain 1 8th pick
- o Then that order is repeated until draft is complete
- All Trades must be approved by both Captains and subcommittee
- Final Trades must be approved before the commencement of game 5 of the competition
- Fill in players will be graded by the subcommittee and allocated a Tier Level
- Fill in players are allowed if
  - o the team will have <5 players on the court
  - o they are currently registered with Basketball NSW as a Wagga player
  - o they pay the applicable night fee calculated (refer player fees)
  - o they are the appropriate tier level of the
    - Captain Team Pick 1 & 2 = Tier 1 replace with a Level 1 or 2
    - Captain Team Pick 3 & 4 = Tier 2 replace with a Level 3 or 4
    - Captain Team Pick 5, 6 & 7 = Tier 3/junior replace with a Level 5 or 6

## Games

- 10 min quarters
- The clock will stop in the last two minutes of the last quarter for time outs, every whistle and after each basket (i.e. fully timed)

- 1 time out per team per quarter, if not taken during the quarter the time out is forfeited and can not be carried over to a subsequent quarter
- Man on Man defense must be played except a zone defense will be allowed if a team has < 5 players on the court
- When defending, if your opponent is playing outside the 3-point line, you must have 2 feet outside the key
- Any player that receives a technical foul must go to the bench for 5 minutes, and cannot be replaced on the court (team plays one short)
- Any player receiving a 2<sup>nd</sup> technical foul must leave the stadium, and cannot be replaced on the court (team plays one short for the remainder of the game)
- Any player that receives 3 technical fouls with a season receives a 1 game suspension plus \$50 off teams voucher
- Any team that receives a total of 5 or more technical fouls during the season loses \$100 off teams voucher

## **Player Registration**

ALL individuals intending to play in the Competition must be registered with Wagga Basketball. No player will be allowed to take the court under any circumstance prior to being registered. Registration will now be completed online and will be received by the Association Administrator. **Players can check if registration is current or expired by typing member.basketball.net.au into their browser and logging in with their SportsTG email/password. Once logged in, they'll be able to:**

- Upload a photo
- Update address
- Check membership history
- Check transaction history
- See playing statistics

#### **Player Fees**

The price will be **\$160.00** per individual.

#### Team/Player Nominations

A player may participate in two teams per local competition, provided that each team is in a consecutive division levels ie Div 1, Div 2, Div 3. An age requirement division such as U23 competition are excluded from this rule.

All registration details for player joining team registration forms will be provided to teams after the draft has been completed.

All players must join their team & pay competition fees (and be currently registered) via the online process before they can take the court for round 1. A team list of players who have joined will be forwarded to the team contact before the commencement of competition. The team contact must ensure all players have joined their team prior to commencement of competition and follow up any players who have not joined. If players have not successfully joined their team prior to round 1 they may not be allowed to take the court until the online process has been completed.

#### Team Support BENCH SCORER

All teams will require a bench scorer, if a scorer is not allocated at the start of the game the team may be penalised.

#### Player & Coach Behaviour

Please read the below Code of Behaviour for players and coaches.

In an effort to control inappropriate player behaviour we have implemented immediate action for technical fouls as outlined above. Also the following penalties for an accumulation of Technical Fouls during the season.

- 2 per year Written Warning
  4 per year 2 playing week suspension
- 6 per year 4 playing week suspension
- 8 per year 8 playing week suspension

10 per year – Rest of Season suspension, plus next season suspension.

These penalties are separate to any penalties handed down by the Disciplinary Tribunal.

## WWBA will also be implementing the following for all games;

# • A player who receives a technical foul will be substituted out of the game for five (5) minutes and cannot be replaced by another player for the duration.
